Tax audit is an essential element of self-assessment system. During the audit process, with is carried out with the objective of increasing the rate of voluntary compliance, the Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia (IRBM) applies numerous techniques and tools to examine the taxpayers' records, financial affairs, documentations, substance of documentations and business practices.
